1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the date by which law enforcement agencies must report
1-9 arrests to the Department of Public Safety.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Article 60.08, Code of Criminal
1-12 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (d) Except as otherwise required by applicable state laws or
1-14 regulations, information or data required by this chapter to be
1-15 reported to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice or the
1-16 Department of Public Safety shall be reported promptly but not
1-17 later than the 30th day after the date on which the information or
1-18 data is received by the agency responsible for reporting it except
1-19 in the case of an arrest. An offender's arrest shall be reported to
1-20 the Department of Public Safety not later than the second [~~seventh~~]
1-21 day after the date of the arrest.

1-22 SECTION 2. Subsection (d), Article 60.08, Code of Criminal
1-23 Procedure, as amended by this Act, applies only to an arrest made on
1-24 or after September 1, 2011.

1-25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
