4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 521.101, Transportation Code, is amended
- by adding Subsection (k) to read as follows:
- 7 (k) The department may include a color or laser engraved
- 8 photograph of the holder of the personal identification
- 9 certificate.
- SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 521.121, Transportation 10
- Code, as amended by Chapters 316 (H.B. 598) and 1146 (H.B. 2730), 11
- Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, is reenacted 12
- 13 and amended to read as follows:
- 14 (a) The driver's license must include:
- 15 (1) a distinguishing number assigned by the department
- to the license holder; 16
- a color or laser engraved photograph of the entire 17
- face of the holder; 18
- (3) the full name and date of birth of the holder; 19
- 20 (4) a brief description of the holder; and
- the license holder's residence address or, for a 21
- 22 license holder using the procedure under Subsection (c), the street
- 23 address of the courthouse in which the license holder or license
- holder's spouse serves as a federal judge or state judge. 24

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 522.030, Transportation Code, is amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 522.030. CONTENT OF LICENSE. A commercial driver's
- 4 license must:
- 5 (1) be marked "Commercial Driver License" or "CDL";
- 6 (2) be, to the extent practicable, tamper-proof; and
- 7 (3) include:
- 8 (A) the name and mailing address of the person to
- 9 whom it is issued;
- 10 (B) the person's color or laser engraved
- 11 photograph;
- 12 (C) a physical description of the person,
- 13 including sex, height, and eye color;
- 14 (D) the person's date of birth;
- 15 (E) a number or identifier the department
- 16 considers appropriate;
- 17 (F) the person's signature;
- 18 (G) each class of commercial motor vehicle that
- 19 the person is authorized to drive, with any endorsements or
- 20 restrictions;
- 21 (H) the name of this state; and
- (I) the dates between which the license is valid.
- 23 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 24 a driver's license, personal identification certificate, or
- 25 commercial driver's license issued or renewed on or after the
- 26 effective date of this Act. A driver's license, personal
- 27 identification certificate, or commercial driver's license issued

- 1 or renewed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 2 law in effect when the license or certificate was issued, and the
- 3 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 5. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 5 over another Act of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011,
- 6 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 7 codes.
- 8 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
