1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to a photograph on a personal identification certificate,
1-11 driver's license, or commercial driver's license.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 521.101, Transportation Code, is amended
1-14 by adding Subsection (k) to read as follows:

1-15 (k) The department may include a color or laser engraved
1-16 photograph of the holder of the personal identification
1-17 certificate.

1-18 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 521.121, Transportation
1-19 Code, as amended by Chapters 316 (H.B. 598) and 1146 (H.B. 2730),
1-20 Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, is reenacted
1-21 and amended to read as follows:

1-22 (a) The driver's license must include:

1-23 (1) a distinguishing number assigned by the department
1-24 to the license holder;

1-25 (2) a color or laser engraved photograph of the entire
1-26 face of the holder;

1-27 (3) the full name and date of birth of the holder;

1-28 (4) a brief description of the holder; and

1-29 (5) the license holder's residence address or, for a
1-30 license holder using the procedure under Subsection (c), the street
1-31 address of the courthouse in which the license holder or license
1-32 holder's spouse serves as a federal judge or state judge.

1-33 SECTION 3. Section 522.030, Transportation Code, is amended
1-34 to read as follows:

1-35 Sec. 522.030. CONTENT OF LICENSE. A commercial driver's
1-36 license must:

1-37 (1) be marked "Commercial Driver License" or "CDL";

1-38 (2) be, to the extent practicable, tamper-proof; and

1-39 (3) include:

1-40 (A) the name and mailing address of the person to
1-41 whom it is issued;

1-42 (B) the person's color or laser engraved
1-43 photograph;

1-44 (C) a physical description of the person,
1-45 including sex, height, and eye color;

1-46 (D) the person's date of birth;

1-47 (E) a number or identifier the department
1-48 considers appropriate;

1-49 (F) the person's signature;

1-50 (G) each class of commercial motor vehicle that
1-51 the person is authorized to drive, with any endorsements or
1-52 restrictions;

1-53 (H) the name of this state; and

1-54 (I) the dates between which the license is valid.

1-55 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
1-56 a driver's license, personal identification certificate, or
1-57 commercial driver's license issued or renewed on or after the
1-58 effective date of this Act. A driver's license, personal
1-59 identification certificate, or commercial driver's license issued
1-60 or renewed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
1-61 law in effect when the license or certificate was issued, and the
1-62 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-63 SECTION 5. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails

2-1 over another Act of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011,
2-2 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
2-3 codes.

2-4 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
