A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to restrictions on school districts making available to
3	students food containing industrially produced trans fat.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 38.0111 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 38.0111. RESTRICTIONS ON FOOD CONTAINING INDUSTRIALLY
8	PRODUCED TRANS FAT. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Industrially produced trans fat" includes
10	vegetable shortening, margarine, and partially hydrogenated
11	vegetable oil.

- 12 (2) "School food service establishment" means a place
 13 that regularly sells or serves food on a school campus.
- 14 <u>(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c) or (d), a school</u>
 15 district may not make available to students through a vending
- 16 machine or a school food service establishment a food that contains
- 17 industrially produced trans fat or that was prepared using another
- 18 food that contains industrially produced trans fat.
- 19 <u>(c) Subsection (b) does not apply on a day that school is not</u> 20 in session or:
- 21 (1) earlier than 30 minutes before the beginning of
- 22 the first scheduled class of the day; or
- 23 (2) later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the
- 24 last scheduled class of the day.

- 1 (d) Subsection (b) does not apply to a food that:
- 2 (1) is provided to a school district as part of a
- 3 United States Department of Agriculture meal program; or
- 4 (2) contains zero grams of trans fat per serving,
- 5 according to the manufacturer's documentation or the label on the
- 6 food, as required by state or federal law or regulations.
- 7 (e) The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary for the
- 8 <u>administration of this section.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 38.0111, Education Code, as added by
- 10 this Act, applies beginning with the 2012-2013 school year.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
