BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-9 1-10 1-11 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 38.0111 to read as follows: 1-12 38.0111. RESTRICTIONS ON FOOD CONTAINING INDUSTRIALLY 1-13 PRODUCED TRANS FAT. (a) In this section: 1-14 "Industrially 1**-**15 1**-**16 fat" (1) produced trans includes margarine, and partially hydrogenated vegetable shortening, 1-17 vegetable oil. "School food service establishment" means a place 1-18 $\overline{(2)}$ that regularly sells or serves food on a school campus.

(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c) or (d), a school district may not make available to students through a vending 1-19 1-20 1-21 machine or a school food service establishment a food that contains 1-22 1-23 industrially produced trans fat or that was prepared using another 1-24 food that contains industrially produced trans fat. 1-25 1-26 Subsection (b) does not apply on a day that school is not (c) in session or: earlier than 30 minutes before the beginning of 1-27 (1)1-28 the first scheduled class of the day; or (2) later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the last scheduled class of the day.

(d) Subsection (b) does not apply to a food that: 1-29 1-30 1-31 1-32 (1) is provided to a school district as part of a United States Department of Agriculture meal program; or 1-33 (2) contains zero grams of trans fat per serving, according to the manufacturer's documentation or the label on the food, as required by state or federal law or regulations. 1-34 1-35 1-36 1-37 (e) The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary for the 1-38 administration of this section. SECTION 2. Section 38.0111, Education Code, as added by this Act, applies beginning with the 2012-2013 school year.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-39 1-40 1-41 1-42 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-43 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-44
