A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to liability of certain local emergency management or 2 3 homeland security organizations. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subdivision (1), Section 101.001, Civil Practice 5 6 and Remedies Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 "Emergency service organization" means: (1)8 (A) a volunteer fire department, rescue squad, or an emergency medical services provider that is: 9 10 (i) [(A)] operated by its members; and (ii) [(B)] exempt from state taxes by being 11 12 listed as an exempt organization under Section 151.310 or 171.083, 13 Tax Code; or 14 (B) a local emergency management or homeland 15 security organization that is: (i) formed and operated as a state resource 16 17 in accordance with the statewide homeland security strategy developed by the governor under Section 421.002, Government Code; 18 19 and (ii) responsive to the Texas Division of 20 Emergency Management in carrying out an all-hazards emergency 21 22 management program under Section 418.112, Government Code. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 23 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of 24

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1 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date 2 of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the 3 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for 4 that purpose.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
