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## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to information subject to the public information law. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: Δ SECTION 1. Section 552.002, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as 5 6 follows: In this chapter, "public information" means information 7 (a) 8 that is created, collected, assembled, possessed, used, relied upon, or maintained under a law or ordinance or in connection with 9 the transaction of official business: 10 by a governmental body; [or] 11 12 (2) for a governmental body and the governmental body owns the information or has a right of access to it; or 13 14 (3) by any person, including a government agency, 15 board, or institution or an individual, corporation or other business entity, or nonprofit organization that performs a public 16 17 function, provides research or consulting services, or conducts a study at the request of a governmental body; or 18 (d) In this chapter, "public information" includes 19 information stored in electronic format that contains public 20 documents, public records, or a communication of official business, 21 regardless of whether the information is stored on a server or in a 22 computer facility owned or maintained by a governmental body. 23

24 SECTION 2. Section 552.003, Government Code, is amended by

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adding Subdivisions (1-a) and (4-a) and amending Subdivision (5) to 1 2 read as follows: (1-a) "Administer" includes functions performed 3 4 pursuant to a contract to which a governmental body is a party, including functions that have been completely delegated to a 5 6 nongovernmental entity. (4-a) "Public function" means: 7 (A) a function performed or administered by: 8 9 (i) a governmental body; or (ii) an elected or appointed public 10 11 official of the state or any political subdivision of the state; and 12 (B) functions that are, wholly or partly, 13 supported with public funds. "Public funds" means funds of the state or of a 14 (5) governmental subdivision of the state, including funds received 15 16 from the federal government or as a result of intergovernmental 17 transfers. 18 SECTION 3. Subchapter Z, Chapter 2252, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 2252.907 to read as follows: 19 20 Sec. 2252.907. CONTRACTS INVOLVING EXCHANGE OR CREATION OF PUBLIC INFORMATION. (a) A contract between a governmental entity 21 that receives state funds and a vendor, institution, individual, 22 23 corporation or other business entity, or nonprofit organization 24 that performs a public function involving the exchange or creation 25 of public information must: (1) be drafted in consideration of the requirements of 26 27 Chapter 552; and

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1	(2) if the information is to be exchanged or stored in
2	an electronic format, contain a provision that the vendor or other
3	contracting entity must make the information available in a
4	specific electronic format that is:
5	(A) agreed on in the contract; and
6	(B) accessible by the public.
7	(b) The requirements of Subsection (a) apply to contracts
8	between the vendor or other contracting entity that performs a
9	public function and a subcontractor engaged to further the
10	performance of the public function.
11	(c) This section may not be waived by contract or otherwise.
12	(d) In this section, "governmental entity" means:
13	(1) a state agency, board, commission, office,
14	department, or other entity in the executive, judicial, or
15	legislative branch of state government, including an institution of
16	higher education as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code; and
17	(2) a political subdivision, including a county,
18	municipality, school district, or other special district or
19	authority of this state.
20	SECTION 4. (a) The changes in law made by this Act by
21	amending Sections 552.002 and 552.003, Government Code, apply only
22	to a request for the disclosure of public information made on or
23	after the effective date of this Act. A request for the disclosure
24	of public information made before the effective date of this Act is
25	governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
26	of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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27 (b) Section 2252.907, Government Code, as added by this Act,

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applies only to a contract for which a governmental entity first 1 advertises or otherwise solicits bids, proposals, offers, or 2 3 qualifications on or after the effective date of this Act. А contract for which a governmental entity advertised or otherwise 4 solicited bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications before the 5 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect 6 7 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 8

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
