- 2 relating to the hotel occupancy tax on the price paid for a hotel

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 156.001, Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 156.001. <u>DEFINITIONS</u> [<u>DEFINITION</u>]. In this chapter:
- 8 (1) "Hotel" [, "hotel"] means a building in which
- 9 members of the public obtain sleeping accommodations for
- 10 consideration. The term includes a hotel, motel, tourist home,
- 11 tourist house, tourist court, lodging house, inn, rooming house, or
- 12 bed and breakfast. The term does not include:
- (A) $\left[\frac{1}{1}\right]$ a hospital, sanitarium, or nursing
- 14 home; or
- (B) $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ a dormitory or other housing facility
- 16 owned or leased and operated by an institution of higher education
- 17 or a private or independent institution of higher education as
- 18 those terms are defined by Section 61.003, Education Code, used by
- 19 the institution for the purpose of providing sleeping
- 20 accommodations for persons engaged in an educational program or
- 21 activity at the institution.
- 22 (2) "Price" means, in relation to the amount or price
- 23 paid for a room in a hotel, the retail price paid by a person for the
- 24 ultimate right to use or possess the room, including any booking,

- 1 handling, or similar fee or charge paid by or on behalf of the
- 2 person.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 351.001, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 4 Subdivision (12) to read as follows:
- 5 (12) "Price," in relation to the amount or price paid
- 6 for a room in a hotel, has the meaning assigned by Section 156.001.
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 352.001, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 8 Subdivision (2-a) to read as follows:
- 9 (2-a) "Price," in relation to the amount or price paid
- 10 for a room in a hotel, has the meaning assigned by Section 156.001.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act is a clarification of existing law and
- 12 does not imply that existing law may be construed as inconsistent
- 13 with the law as amended by this Act.
- 14 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
