A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact
3	Commission.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 401.248, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
7	(e) The compact waste disposal facility license holder may
8	not accept compact waste at the compact waste disposal facility
9	unless the compact commission established by the compact under
10	Section 403.006 has adopted bylaws necessary to carry out the terms
11	of the compact.
12	SECTION 2. Chapter 403, Health and Safety Code, is amended
13	by adding Section 403.0005 to read as follows:
14	Sec. 403.0005. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
15	(1) "Commission" means the commission established by
16	Article III of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal
17	Compact.
18	(2) "Host state commissioner" means a person who is
19	appointed from this state to serve on the commission under this
20	chapter.
21	SECTION 3. Sections 403.002 and 403.004, Health and Safety
22	Code, are amended to read as follows:
23	Sec. 403.002. TERMS OF COMMISSION MEMBERS; VACANCY. <u>Host</u>
24	[A host] state commissioners serve staggered six-year terms, with

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1 <u>the terms of two host state commissioners expiring on February 1 of</u> 2 <u>each even-numbered year. A host state</u> commissioner serves [for a 3 term of six years and] until a successor is appointed and qualified. 4 A vacancy in the office of <u>host state</u> commissioner is filled for the 5 unexpired term by appointment of the governor.

6 Sec. 403.004. COMPENSATION. A host state commissioner is 7 not entitled to compensation for performing the duties of <u>host</u> 8 <u>state</u> commissioner but is entitled to reimbursement for <u>reasonable</u> 9 [actual] and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of the 10 duties of <u>host state</u> commissioner.

SECTION 4. Chapter 403, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Sections 403.0051, 403.0052, 403.0053, 403.0054, and 403.0055 to read as follows:

Sec. 403.0051. COMMISSION AS INDEPENDENT ENTITY. (a) The commission is an independent entity and not a program, department, or other division of, or administratively attached to, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

18 (b) Money for the commission may not be appropriated as part 19 of an appropriation for the Texas Commission on Environmental 20 Quality.

21 <u>Sec. 403.0052. BIENNIAL REPORTS TO LEGISLATURE. On or</u> 22 <u>before December 1 of each even-numbered year, the commission shall</u> 23 <u>file with the governor and the appropriate legislative committees a</u> 24 <u>written report that includes:</u>

25 <u>(1) a statement of the activities of the commission</u>
26 <u>during the preceding fiscal biennium;</u>

27 (2) the commission's recommendations for necessary and

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desirable legislation; and 1 2 (3) an accounting of all funds received and disbursed 3 by the commission during the preceding biennium. Sec. 403.0053. ATTORNEY GENERAL TO REPRESENT COMMISSION. 4 The attorney general shall represent the commission under this 5 6 chapter in all matters before the state courts and any court of the 7 United States. Sec. 403.0054. APPLICABILITY OF SUNSET ACT. (a) 8 The 9 commission is subject to review under Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act), as if it were a state agency subject to review 10 11 under that chapter, but may not be abolished under that chapter. (b) The commission shall be reviewed during the period in 12 13 which state agencies scheduled to be reviewed or abolished in 2013 14 and every 12th year after that year are reviewed. 15 (c) The commission shall pay the cost incurred by the Sunset 16 Advisory Commission in performing a review of the commission under this section. The Sunset Advisory Commission shall determine the 17 18 cost, and the commission shall pay the amount promptly on receipt of a statement from the Sunset Advisory Commission detailing the cost. 19 20 Sec. 403.0055. AUDIT. The commission is subject to audit by the state auditor in accordance with Chapter 321, Government Code. 21 22 SECTION 5. The term of office of a person serving as a host state commissioner of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste 23 24 Disposal Compact Commission on the effective date of this Act expires February 1, 2012. To begin the staggering of terms, the 25 governor shall appoint host state commissioners, in accordance with 26 the provisions of Section 403.002, Health and Safety Code, as 27

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amended by this Act, as follows: 1 2 (1) two host state commissioners to terms expiring 3 February 1, 2014; (2) two host state commissioners to terms expiring 4 5 February 1, 2016; and 6 (3) two host state commissioners to terms expiring 7 February 1, 2018. SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011. 8

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
