## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact
- 3 Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 401.248, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) The compact waste disposal facility license holder may
- 8 not accept compact waste at the compact waste disposal facility
- 9 unless the compact commission established by the compact under
- 10 Section 403.006 has adopted bylaws necessary to carry out the terms
- 11 of the compact.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 403, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 13 by adding Section 403.0005 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 403.0005. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
- 15 (1) "Commission" means the commission established by
- 16 Article III of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste Disposal
- 17 Compact.
- 18 (2) "Host state commissioner" means a person who is
- 19 appointed from this state to serve on the commission under this
- 20 <u>chapter.</u>
- SECTION 3. Sections 403.002 and 403.004, Health and Safety
- 22 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 403.002. TERMS OF COMMISSION MEMBERS; VACANCY. Host
- 24 [A host] state commissioners serve staggered six-year terms, with

- 1 the terms of two host state commissioners expiring on February 1 of
- 2 each even-numbered year. A host state commissioner serves [for a
- 3 term of six years and] until a successor is appointed and qualified.
- 4 A vacancy in the office of host state commissioner is filled for the
- 5 unexpired term by appointment of the governor.
- 6 Sec. 403.004. COMPENSATION. A host state commissioner is
- 7 not entitled to compensation for performing the duties of host
- 8 state commissioner but is entitled to reimbursement for actual and
- 9 necessary expenses incurred in the performance of the duties of
- 10 <u>host state</u> commissioner.
- 11 SECTION 4. Chapter 403, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 12 by adding Sections 403.0051, 403.0052, 403.0053, 403.0054, and
- 13 403.0055 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 403.0051. COMMISSION AS INDEPENDENT ENTITY. (a) The
- 15 commission is an independent entity and not a program, department,
- 16 or other division of, or administratively attached to, the Texas
- 17 Commission on Environmental Quality.
- 18 (b) Money for the commission may not be appropriated as part
- 19 of an appropriation for the Texas Commission on Environmental
- 20 Quality.
- Sec. 403.0052. BIENNIAL REPORTS TO LEGISLATURE. On or
- 22 <u>before December 1 of each even-numbered year, the commission shall</u>
- 23 file with the governor and the appropriate legislative committees a
- 24 written report that includes:
- 25 (1) a statement of the activities of the commission
- 26 during the preceding fiscal biennium;
- 27 (2) the commission's recommendations for necessary and

- 1 <u>desirable legislation; and</u>
- 2 (3) an accounting of all funds received and disbursed
- 3 by the commission during the preceding biennium.
- 4 Sec. 403.0053. ATTORNEY GENERAL TO REPRESENT COMMISSION.
- 5 The attorney general shall represent the commission under this
- 6 chapter in all matters before the state courts and any court of the
- 7 <u>United States.</u>
- 8 Sec. 403.0054. APPLICABILITY OF SUNSET ACT. (a) The
- 9 commission is subject to review under Chapter 325, Government Code
- 10 (Texas Sunset Act), as if it were a state agency subject to review
- 11 under that chapter, but may not be abolished under that chapter.
- 12 (b) The commission shall be reviewed during each period in
- 13 which the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality is reviewed.
- 14 (c) The commission shall pay the cost incurred by the Sunset
- 15 Advisory Commission in performing a review of the commission under
- 16 this section. The Sunset Advisory Commission shall determine the
- 17 cost, and the commission shall pay the amount promptly on receipt of
- 18 a statement from the Sunset Advisory Commission detailing the cost.
- 19 Sec. 403.0055. AUDIT. The commission is subject to audit by
- 20 the state auditor in accordance with Chapter 321, Government Code.
- 21 SECTION 5. The term of office of a person serving as a host
- 22 state commissioner of the Texas Low-Level Radioactive Waste
- 23 Disposal Compact Commission on the effective date of this Act
- 24 expires February 1, 2012. To begin the staggering of terms, the
- 25 governor shall appoint host state commissioners, in accordance with
- 26 the provisions of Section 403.002, Health and Safety Code, as
- 27 amended by this Act, as follows:

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- 1 (1) two host state commissioners to terms expiring
- 2 February 1, 2014;
- 3 (2) two host state commissioners to terms expiring
- 4 February 1, 2016; and
- 5 (3) two host state commissioners to terms expiring
- 6 February 1, 2018.
- 7 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
