4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a-2), Section 28.009, Education 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 (a-2) A school district is not required to pay a student's
8 tuition or other associated costs for taking a course under this
9 section. This subsection expires September 1, <u>2013</u> [2011].

SECTION 2. Subsection (g), Section 42.005, Education Code, as effective September 1, 2011, is amended to read as follows:

12 If a student may receive course credit toward the (q) 13 student's high school academic requirements and toward the student's higher education academic requirements for a single 14 15 course, including a course provided under Section 28.009 by a public institution of higher education, the time during which the 16 17 student attends the course shall be counted as part of the minimum number of instructional hours required for a student to be 18 considered a full-time student in average daily attendance for 19 purposes of this section. 20

21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
