A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the composition of the Texas Commission on Fire
- 3 Protection and the disposition of certain fees collected by the
- 4 commission.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 419.004(a), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The commission is composed of the following 13 members:
- 9 (1) two members to be selected from a list of five
- 10 names submitted by the Texas Fire Chiefs Association who are chief
- 11 officers with a minimum rank that is equivalent to the position
- 12 immediately below that of the fire chief and who are employed in
- 13 fire departments as defined by Section 419.021 that are under the
- 14 jurisdiction of the commission, at least one of whom must be the
- 15 head of a fire department and one of whom must be employed by a
- 16 political subdivision with a population of less than 150,000
- 17 $[\frac{100,000}{}];$
- 18 (2) two members to be selected from a list of five
- 19 names submitted by the Texas State Association of Fire Fighters who
- 20 are fire protection personnel as defined by Section 419.021 with
- 21 the rank of battalion chief or below and who are employed in fire
- 22 departments or other appropriate local authorities under the
- 23 jurisdiction of the commission, one of whom must be employed by a
- 24 political subdivision with a population of less than 150,000

- 2 (3) two members to be selected from a list of five
- 3 names submitted by the State Firemen's and Fire Marshals'
- 4 Association of Texas who are volunteer fire chiefs or volunteer
- 5 fire fighters;
- 6 (4) one certified fire protection engineer;
- 7 (5) one certified arson investigator or certified fire
- 8 protection inspector;
- 9 (6) one fire protection instructor from an institution
- 10 of higher education as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code;
- 11 and
- 12 (7) four public members.
- SECTION 2. Section 419.026(d), Government Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (d) The commission shall send the fees authorized by
- 16 Subsection (a) and Section 419.033(b) to the comptroller, who shall
- 17 deposit [50 percent of] the fees collected annually into [the
- 18 general revenue fund and 50 percent of the fees collected annually
- 19 into a special account in the general revenue fund dedicated for
- 20 use by the commission. Except as otherwise provided by this
- 21 chapter, 50 percent of the special fund created under this
- 22 subsection may be used only to defray the commission's costs in
- 23 performing inspections under Section 419.027 and the other 50
- 24 percent may be used only to provide training assistance under
- 25 Section 419.031.
- 26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
