A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT
2	relating to group health benefits coverage for persons wrongfully
3	imprisoned.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 103.001, Civil Practice
6	and Remedies Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 103.001. CLAIMANTS ENTITLED TO COMPENSATION AND HEALTH
8	BENEFITS COVERAGE.
9	SECTION 2. Section 103.001, Civil Practice and Remedies
10	Code, is amended by adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as
11	follows:
12	(d) Subject to this section, a person entitled to
13	compensation under Subsection (a) is also eligible to obtain group
14	health benefit plan coverage through the Texas Department of
15	Criminal Justice as if the person were an employee of the
16	department. This subsection does not entitle the person's spouse
17	or other dependent or family member to group health benefit plan
18	coverage. Coverage may be obtained under this subsection for a
19	period of time equal to the total period the claimant served for the
20	crime for which the claimant was wrongfully imprisoned, including
21	any period during which the claimant was released on parole or to
22	mandatory supervision or required to register under Chapter 62,
23	Code of Criminal Procedure. A person who elects to obtain coverage
24	under this subsection shall pay a monthly contribution equal to the

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total amount of the monthly contributions for that coverage for an 1 2 employee of the department. (e) Notwithstanding Section 103.053(c), annuity payments 3 4 may be reduced by an amount necessary to make the payments required by Subsection (d), and that amount shall be transferred to an 5 appropriate account as provided by the comptroller by rule to fund 6 7 that coverage. SECTION 3. Section 103.051, Civil Practice and Remedies 8 9 Code, is amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows: (f) To apply for coverage through the Texas Department of 10 Criminal Justice under Section 103.001(d), the claimant must file 11 12 with the department: 13 (1) an application for coverage provided for that 14 purpose by the department; and 15 (2) a statement by the comptroller that the 16 comptroller has determined the claimant to be eligible for compensation under this subchapter. 17 18 SECTION 4. Subchapter C, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, is amended by adding Section 1551.115 to read as follows: 19 20 Sec. 1551.115. PARTICIPATION BY WRONGFULLY IMPRISONED PERSONS. Subject to Section 103.001, Civil Practice and Remedies 21 Code, a person who is entitled to compensation under Chapter 103, 22 Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is eligible to obtain health 23 benefit plan coverage under the group benefits program in the 24 manner and to the extent that an employee of the Texas Department of 25 Criminal Justice would be entitled to coverage, except that this 26 27 section does not entitle the person's spouse or other dependent or

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1 family member to coverage.

2 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies to a 3 person the comptroller of public accounts has determined to be 4 eligible for compensation as provided by Subsection (b), Section 5 103.051, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, regardless of whether 6 the eligibility determination is made before, on, or after the 7 effective date of this Act.

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SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2012.

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
