A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to reporting concerning inmates who are confined in county
3	jails and subject to federal immigration detainers.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 511.0101, Government
6	Code, as amended by Chapters 977 (H.B. 3654) and 1215 (S.B. 1009),
7	Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, is reenacted
8	and amended to read as follows:
9	(a) Each county shall submit to the commission on or before
10	the fifth day of each month a report containing the following
11	information:
12	(1) the number of prisoners confined in the county
13	jail on the first day of the month, classified on the basis of the
14	following categories:
15	(A) total prisoners;
16	(B) pretrial Class C misdemeanor offenders;
17	(C) pretrial Class A and B misdemeanor offenders;
18	(D) convicted misdemeanor offenders;
19	(E) felony offenders whose penalty has been
20	reduced to a misdemeanor;
21	(F) pretrial felony offenders;
22	(G) convicted felony offenders;
23	(H) prisoners detained on bench warrants;
24	(I) prisoners detained for parole violations;

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(J) prisoners detained for federal officers;

(K) prisoners awaiting transfer to the institutional division of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice following conviction of a felony or revocation of probation, parole, or release on mandatory supervision and for whom paperwork and processing required for transfer have been completed;

7 (L) prisoners detained after having been
8 transferred from another jail and for whom the commission has made a
9 payment under Subchapter F, Chapter 499, Government Code;

10 (M) prisoners <u>for whom an immigration detainer</u> 11 <u>has been issued by United States Immigration and Customs</u> 12 <u>Enforcement</u> [who are known to be pregnant]; and

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(N) other prisoners;

14 (2) the total capacity of the county jail on the first15 day of the month;

16 (3) the total number of prisoners who were confined in 17 the county jail during the preceding month, based on a count 18 conducted on each day of that month, who were known or had been 19 determined to be pregnant; [and]

20 (4) <u>the total cost to the county during the preceding</u>
21 <u>month of housing prisoners described by Subdivision (1)(M),</u>
22 <u>calculated based on the average daily cost of housing a prisoner in</u>
23 <u>the county jail; and</u>

24 <u>(5)</u> certification by the reporting official that the 25 information in the report is accurate.

26 SECTION 2. A county shall submit the first report required 27 by Section 511.0101, Government Code, as amended by this Act, not

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1 later than October 5, 2011.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
