- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 418.108(i), Chapter 418, Government
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (i) A declaration under this section may, include a
- 7 restriction that exceeds a restriction authorized by Section
- 8 352.051, Local Government Code, <u>if the Keetch-Byram Index level in</u>
- 9 Section 352.051(a)(2), Local Government Code, is exceeded and the
- 10 governor has suspended the sale, dispensing, or transportation of
- 11 the items in Section 418.019 within the county. A restriction that
- 12 exceeds a restriction authorized by Section 352.051(c), Local
- 13 Government Code, is effective only:
- 14 (1) for 60 hours unless extended by the governor; and
- 15 (2) if the county judge requests the governor to grant
- 16 an extension of the restriction.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
