A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to requiring the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board
3	to create a tool to allow prospective students to compare general
4	academic teaching institutions by certain criteria.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 61.09021 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 61.09021. COMPARISON TOOL. (a) The board shall make
9	available to the public on the board's Internet website a search
10	tool that allows a person to compare general academic teaching
11	institutions that meet certain criteria selected by the person,
12	including offering a particular major or program of study.
13	(b) The comparison tool required under this section must:
14	(1) be accessible from the board's Internet website;
15	(2) allow a user to identify general academic teaching
16	institutions according to selection criteria as determined by the
17	board; and
18	(3) be accessible to the public without requiring
19	registration or use of a user name, password, or other user
20	<pre>identification.</pre>
21	(c) The comparison tool required under this section must
22	generate a comparison chart in a grid format that:
23	(1) lists the general academic teaching institutions
24	that match a user's search criteria; and

- 1 (2) provides information for each institution listed
- 2 that the board has determined would aid a prospective student in
- 3 evaluating the institution.
- 4 (d) The Internet page displaying the comparison chart must
- 5 <u>include a link to the Internet website of the Texas Workforce</u>
- 6 Commission.
- 7 (e) To the extent practicable, the information provided
- 8 under Subsection (c) must consist of information that a general
- 9 academic teaching institution is required to report to the board
- 10 under another provision of law, including board rule.
- 11 (f) Each general academic teaching institution shall
- 12 provide to the board the information to be provided under
- 13 Subsection (c) not later than October 1, or a date determined by the
- 14 board, of each year. The board shall update the comparison tool as
- 15 soon as practicable after receiving information from each
- 16 <u>institution</u>.
- SECTION 2. Not later than February 1, 2013, the Texas Higher
- 18 Education Coordinating Board shall create and post on the board's
- 19 Internet website the comparison tool required by Section 61.09021,
- 20 Education Code, as added by this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
