- 12 for the issuance of a license to an applicant who is the spouse of a
- 13 person serving on active duty as a member of the armed forces of the

- 15 (b) Rules adopted under this section must include
- 16 provisions to allow:
- 17 (1) alternative demonstrations of competency to meet
- 18 the requirements for obtaining the license; and
- 19 (2) a period during which an otherwise qualified
- 20 person may seek employment or practice with an expired license.
- 21 (c) The executive director of the Texas Department of
- 22 Licensing and Regulation may issue a license by endorsement in the
- 23 same manner as the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
