## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to tuition and fee exemptions at public institutions of
- 3 higher education for certain Texas military veterans.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 54.203, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (a-3) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-3) Notwithstanding Subsection (a)(4), a person who meets
- 8 the requirements of Subsection (a)(4), other than the requirement
- 9 that the person must have served on active military duty for more
- 10 than the stated number of days, is entitled to the exemption
- 11 provided by Subsection (a)(4) regardless of the length of the
- 12 member's active military duty if the person was a member of the
- 13 Texas National Guard or the Texas Air National Guard who was
- 14 assigned to a theater of combat operation with the armed forces of
- 15 the United States.
- SECTION 2. Subsection (a-3), Section 54.203, Education
- 17 Code, as added by this Act, applies beginning with tuition and fees
- 18 at a public institution of higher education for the 2011 fall
- 19 semester. Tuition and fees for a term or semester before the 2011
- 20 fall semester are covered by the law in effect immediately before
- 21 the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 22 effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
