13 Texas National Guard or the Texas Air National Guard who was

14 assigned to a theater of combat operation with the armed forces of

15 <u>the United States.</u>

SECTION 2. Section 54.203(a-3), Education Code, as added by

17 this Act, applies beginning with tuition and fees at a public

18 institution of higher education for the 2011 fall semester.

19 Tuition and fees for a term or semester before the 2011 fall

20 semester are covered by the law in effect immediately before the

21 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in

22 effect for that purpose.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
