- relating to the establishment of the College Credit for Heroes 2

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code,
- amended by adding Section 302.0031 to read as follows: 6
- Sec. 302.0031. COLLEGE CREDIT FOR HEROES PROGRAM. (a) In 7
- this section, "institution of higher education" has the meaning 8
- 9 assigned by Section 61.003, Education Code.
- (b) The commission shall establish and administer the 10
- College Credit for Heroes demonstration program to identify, 11
- develop, and support methods to maximize academic credit awarded by 12
- institutions of higher education to veterans and military 13
- 14 servicemembers for military experience, education, and training
- obtained during military service in order to expedite the entry of 15
- 16 veterans and military servicemembers into the workforce.
- (c) The commission shall work cooperatively with other 17
- state agencies, including the Texas Higher Education Coordinating 18
- Board, public junior colleges, and other institutions of higher 19
- education to accomplish the purposes of this section. 20
- 21 (d) The commission may award grants to state, local, or
- private entities that perform activities related to the purposes of 22
- 23 this section.
- 24 (e) The commission shall administer the program using money

- 1 previously appropriated to the commission or received from federal
- 2 or other sources.
- 3 (f) The commission may adopt rules as necessary for the
- 4 administration of this section.
- 5 (g) Not later than November 1, 2012, the commission, after
- 6 consultation with the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board,
- 7 shall report to the legislature and the governor on:
- 8 <u>(1) the results of any grants awarded under this</u>
- 9 section;
- 10 (2) the best practices for veterans and military
- 11 servicemembers to achieve maximum academic credit at institutions
- 12 of higher education for military experience, education, and
- 13 training obtained during military service;
- 14 (3) measures needed to facilitate the award of
- 15 <u>academic credit</u> by institutions of higher education for military
- 16 experience, education, and training obtained during military
- 17 service; and
- 18 (4) other related measures needed to facilitate the
- 19 entry of trained, qualified veterans and military servicemembers
- 20 into the workforce.
- 21 (h) This subsection and Subsection (g) expire January 1,
- 22 2013.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
