A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the operation of plug-in electric motor vehicles.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 224.153, Transportation Code, is amended
5	by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
6	(e) A motor vehicle displaying the "plug-in electric
7	vehicle" insignia authorized by Section 502.186 in an easily
8	readable location on the back of the vehicle may use a high
9	occupancy vehicle lane regardless of the number of occupants in the
10	vehicle unless the use would violate federal transit or highway
11	funding restrictions.
12	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
13	is amended by adding Section 502.186 to read as follows:
14	Sec. 502.186. "PLUG-IN ELECTRIC VEHICLE" INSIGNIA FOR
15	CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES. (a) At the time of registration or
16	reregistration of a motor vehicle, the department shall issue a
17	specially designed "plug-in electric vehicle" insignia for a motor
18	vehicle that:
19	(1) is made by a manufacturer primarily for use on
20	public highways;
21	(2) has not been modified from original manufacturer
22	<pre>specifications;</pre>
23	(3) is rated at not more than 8,500 pounds unloaded
24	gross vehicle weight;

1	(4) is acquired for use or lease by a consumer and not
2	for resale;
3	(5) has a speed capability of at least 65 miles per
4	hour;
5	(6) is propelled to a significant extent by an
6	electric motor that draws electricity from a battery that:
7	(A) has a capacity of not less than four kilowatt
8	hours; and
9	(B) is capable of being recharged from an
10	external source of electricity; and
11	(7) is not a recreational vehicle, as defined by
12	Section 522.004(b), that draws power from a battery or a hybrid
13	engine solely for purposes other than propulsion.
14	(b) The department shall issue a "plug-in electric vehicle"
15	insignia under this section to a person who:
16	(1) applies to the department on a form provided by the
17	department; and
18	(2) submits proof that the motor vehicle being
19	registered is a vehicle described by Subsection (a).
20	(c) The department may charge a fee for the issuance of a
21	"plug-in electric vehicle" insignia under this section. The fee
22	may not exceed \$20 per motor vehicle.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
