## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating to the conditions of employment for firefighters employed
3	by certain emergency services districts; providing penalties.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 5, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Chapter 179A to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 179A. CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR FIREFIGHTERS OF CERTAIN
- 8 EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICTS
- 9 Sec. 179A.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "firefighter"
- 10 means a person defined as fire protection personnel under Section
- 11 419.021, Government Code.

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- Sec. 179A.002. APPLICABILITY. (a) This chapter applies to
- 13 <u>a fire department of and firefighters employed by an emergency</u>
- 14 services district with a population of more than 50,000.
- (b) For purposes of this chapter, a reference to a
- 16 municipality or a municipal official in a provision of law made
- 17 applicable by this chapter to an emergency services district is
- 18 considered to be a reference to the district or the official of the
- 19 district responsible for the performance of the duty to which the
- 20 provision applies.
- Sec. 179A.003. PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS; LONGEVITY PAY;
- 22 CLASSIFICATION PAY; PENALTY. (a) Sections 141.008, 141.032, and
- 23 141.033 apply to a firefighter employed by an emergency services
- 24 district.

- 1 (b) The penalty under Section 141.035 applies to a person
- 2 who is in charge of the fire department of an emergency services
- 3 district or who is responsible for setting the compensation for
- 4 firefighters employed by a district.
- 5 Sec. 179A.004. ASSISTANCE; BENEFITS; WORKING CONDITIONS;
- 6 PENALTY. Sections 142.001, 142.0013, 142.0015, 142.0016, 142.004,
- 7 142.009, and 142.010 apply to a firefighter employed by an
- 8 emergency services district.
- 9 Sec. 179A.005. CIVIL SERVICE. (a) An emergency services
- 10 district is considered to have adopted Chapter 143. Chapter 143
- 11 applies to the district's fire department in the same manner as the
- 12 chapter applies to a municipality with a population of less than 1.5
- 13 million that adopts that chapter. Subchapters A-F, Chapter 143,
- 14 apply to the district's fire department.
- 15 (b) Each firefighter who has been in the service of the
- 16 emergency services district for more than six months at the time
- 17 this chapter first becomes applicable to the district and who is
- 18 entitled to civil service classification:
- 19 (1) has the status of a civil service employee; and
- 20 (2) is not required to take a competitive examination
- 21 to remain in the position the person occupies at that time.
- 22 (c) The Fire <u>Fighters' Civil Service Commission is</u>
- 23 <u>established in each emergency services district</u>. The president of
- 24 the district's board of emergency services commissioners shall
- 25 appoint the members of the commission not later than the 60th day
- 26 after the date this chapter first becomes applicable to the
- 27 district. Not later than the 30th day after the date the district's

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- 1 first full fiscal year begins after the date this chapter first
- 2 becomes applicable to the district, the district's board of
- 3 emergency services commissioners shall implement this chapter.
- 4 (d) The office of Director of Fire Fighters' Civil Service
- 5 is established in each emergency services district. The Fire
- 6 Fighters' Civil Service Commission shall appoint the director. The
- 7 director shall serve as secretary to the commission and perform
- 8 work incidental to the civil service system as required by the
- 9 commission. The commission may remove the director at any time.
- 10 SECTION 2. (a) On the effective date of this Act, Chapter
- 11 179A, Local Government Code, as added by this Act, first becomes
- 12 applicable to an existing emergency services district.
- 13 (b) The board of emergency services commissioners of an
- 14 emergency services district to which Chapter 143, Local Government
- 15 Code, is, without regard to the holding of an election, applicable
- 16 because of the change in law made by this Act shall implement a
- 17 civil service system for the district in accordance with
- 18 Subchapters A-F, Chapter 143, Local Government Code, and in
- 19 accordance with Chapter 179A, Local Government Code, as added by
- 20 this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
