## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the maintenance by certain hospitals of records
- 3 regarding certain uncompensated care costs.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 311, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 311.034 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 311.034. RECORDS OF CERTAIN COSTS REQUIRED; REPORT.
- 8 (a) A public or private hospital that receives trauma funds under
- 9 Section 773.122, 780.004, or 782.003 or Section 403.106, Government
- 10 Code, shall maintain a record of:
- 11 (1) the amount of uncompensated care costs at the
- 12 hospital resulting from workplace injuries; and
- 13 (2) the cause of each workplace injury for which
- 14 treatment is uncompensated or, if the cause is not known, the name
- 15 of the employer of the injured person.
- 16 (b) A hospital described by Subsection (a) annually shall
- 17 submit to the department a report containing the records required
- 18 by that subsection.

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- 19 <u>(c) The department shall provide technical assistance to a</u>
- 20 hospital described by Subsection (a) to maximize the efficiency of
- 21 reporting under this section.
- 22 SECTION 2. A hospital required to report to the Department
- 23 of State Health Services under Section 311.034, Health and Safety
- 24 Code, as added by this Act, shall submit the initial report required

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- 1 by that section not later than August 1, 2012.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
