- SECTION 1. Section 29.005, Education Code, is amended by 5
- adding Subsection (f) to read as follows: 6
- (f) The written statement of a student's individualized 7
- education program may include only information included in the 8
- model form developed under Section 29.0051(a). 9
- SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 29, Education Code, is 10
- 11 amended by adding Section 29.0051 to read as follows:

- model form for use in developing an individualized education 13
- program under Section 29.005(b). The form must be clear, concise, 14

- developed under 20 U.S.C. Section 1417(e)(1); and 18

- 3 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2011, the Texas
- 4 Education Agency shall develop the model form required under
- 5 Section 29.0051, Education Code, as added by this Act.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
