Sec. 351.045. HEALTH CARE SERVICES IN CERTAIN COUNTIES; 1 2 EMPLOYMENT OF PHYSICIANS. (a) The commissioners court of a county with a population of 3.3 million or more may appoint, contract for, 3 or employ physicians to provide health care services to inmates in 4 5 the custody of the sheriff. 6 (b) This section may not be construed as authorizing the 7 commissioners court to supervise or control the practice of medicine, as prohibited by Subtitle B, Title 3, Occupations Code. 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12

Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
