## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to subcontracting opportunities for historically 3 underutilized businesses under certain state purchasing contracts. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 2161.253(d), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (d) If a state agency determination is made that the contractor failed to implement the subcontracting plan in good 8 faith, the agency, in addition to any other remedies, may: 9 (1) consider the contractor's failure to implement the 10 11 subcontracting plan as substandard performance under the contract 12 when evaluating the contractor's bids in the award of future agency 13 contracts; or 14 (2) bar the contractor from further contracting opportunities with the agency. 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011. 16
