A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 4, Education Code, is amended by adding
- 5 Section 4.003 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 4.003. APPLICABILITY TO HEAD START PROGRAMS. A
- 7 provision in this title applies to a Head Start program only to the
- 8 extent that the provision explicitly provides for that
- 9 applicability.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 5.001, Education Code, is amended by
- 11 adding Subdivision (6-b) to read as follows:
- 12 (6-b) "Public school" means a school that offers a
- 13 course of instruction for students in one or more grades from
- 14 prekindergarten through grade 12, is supported by state tax funds,
- 15 and does not customarily charge tuition. The term includes a Head
- 16 Start program operated in this state, regardless of whether the
- 17 program is operated by a school district or operated by a
- 18 community-based organization and regardless of whether the program
- 19 <u>is located at a school district campus.</u>
- SECTION 3. Section 7.031(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- 22 (b) Unless otherwise prohibited by federal law, the
- 23 commissioner may determine, [solely] for purposes of the program's
- 24 eligibility to receive federal grant funds or participate in

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- 1 <u>federal discount programs</u>, for the purpose of technology services,
- 2 [and] support, and related services, that a Head Start program
- 3 operated in this state by a school district or a community-based
- 4 organization serves the function of an elementary school by
- 5 providing elementary education at one or more program facilities,
- 6 regardless of whether the Head Start program facilities are located
- 7 on a school district campus.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
