## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 551.001(2) and (4), Government Code,
6	are amended to read as follows:
7	(2) "Deliberation" means <u>an</u> [ <del>a verbal</del> ] exchange <u>,</u>
8	whether oral or written, [during a meeting] between a quorum of a
9	governmental body, or between a quorum of a governmental body and
10	another person, concerning an issue within the jurisdiction of the
11	governmental body or any public business. The term includes an
12	e-mail, letter, or other written communication that:
13	(A) is produced by or originates from a member of
14	the governmental body;
15	(B) is circulated among a quorum of the
16	governmental body; and
17	(C) concerns an issue within the jurisdiction of
18	the governmental body or any public business.

governmental body, or between a quorum of a governmental body and

another person, during which public business or public policy over

which the governmental body has supervision or control is discussed

or considered or during which the governmental body takes formal

(A) a deliberation between a quorum of a

- 2 (B) except as otherwise provided by this
- 3 subdivision, a gathering:
- 4 (i) that is conducted by the governmental
- 5 body or for which the governmental body is responsible;
- 6 (ii) at which a quorum of members of the
- 7 governmental body is present or actively participating;
- 8 (iii) that has been called by the
- 9 governmental body; and
- 10 (iv) at which the members receive
- 11 information from, give information to, ask questions of, or receive
- 12 questions from any third person, including an employee of the
- 13 governmental body, about the public business or public policy over
- 14 which the governmental body has supervision or control.
- The term does not include the gathering of a quorum of a
- 16 governmental body at a social function unrelated to the public
- 17 business that is conducted by the body, or the attendance by a
- 18 quorum of a governmental body at a regional, state, or national
- 19 convention or workshop, ceremonial event, or press conference, if
- 20 formal action is not taken and any discussion of public business is
- 21 incidental to the social function, convention, workshop,
- 22 ceremonial event, or press conference.
- The term includes a session of a governmental body.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
