4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 223, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 223.049 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 223.049. PREFERENCE FOR CERTAIN PROVIDERS. (a) In
8	awarding a contract to a private sector provider, the department
9	shall give preference to a private sector provider if:
10	(1) the preference serves to create a positive
11	economic impact on job growth and job retention in this state;
12	(2) the transportation project for which the contract
13	is being awarded is funded entirely from:
14	(A) state funds;
15	(B) local funds; or
16	(C) a combination of state and local funds; and
17	(3) the provider meets department expectations
18	regarding price for the contract.
19	(b) The department, in determining whether the preference
20	serves to create a positive economic impact on job growth and job
21	retention in this state under Subsection (a), may consider a
22	private sector provider's employment presence and business
23	establishments in this state.
24	(c) This section does not apply to the procurement of

- 1 professional services under Subchapter A, Chapter 2254, Government
- 2 Code.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
