## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the creation, fines, and funding of the Railroad
- 3 Commission of Texas operating account.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The Legislature finds that current statute and
- 6 fines under the Natural Resources Code do not accurately serve as a
- 7 deterrent to violations of the code. By increasing existing fines
- 8 and dedicating these fines to the Railroad Commission's Operation
- 9 Account established under SECTION 2 of this bill, the Legislature
- 10 hopes to provide an adequate deterrent for violation.
- 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 81, Natural Resources
- 12 Code, is amended by adding Section 81.021 to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 81.021. RAILROAD COMMISSION OF TEXAS OPERATING
- 14 ACCOUNT. (a) The Railroad Commission of Texas operating account
- 15 is an account in the general revenue fund.
- 16 (b) Money in the account may be appropriated only to the
- 17 commission for the operation of the commission.
- 18 SECTION 3. Section 81.058, Natural Resources Code, is
- 19 amended by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 20 (g) An administrative penalty imposed under this section
- 21 shall be deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 22 operating account established under Section 81.021.
- SECTION 4. Subchapter K, Chapter 85, Natural Resources
- 24 Code, is amended by adding Section 85.390 to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 85.390. DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN PENALTIES. A penalty
- 2 collected under Section 85.385 or 85.3855 shall be deposited to the
- 3 credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas operating account
- 4 <u>established under Section 81.021.</u>
- 5 SECTION 5. Section 111.261, Natural Resources Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 111.261. PENALTY RECOVERABLE BY STATE. (a) A common
- 8 carrier under this chapter is subject to a penalty of not less than
- 9 \$100 nor more than \$1,000\$25,000 for each offense, recoverable in
- 10 the name of the state, if the common carrier:
- 11 (1) violates Section 111.013 through 111.024,
- 12 111.134, 111.135, 111.138, 111.139, 111.141, or 111.142 of this
- 13 code or a valid order of the commission; or
- 14 (2) fails to perform a duty imposed by Section 111.013
- 15 through 111.024, 111.134, 111.135, 111.138, 111.139, 111.141, or
- 16 111.142 of this code.
- 17 (b) A penalty collected under this section shall be
- 18 deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 19 operating account established under Section 81.021.
- 20 SECTION 6. Section 111.263, Natural Resources Code, is
- 21 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 22 <u>(a-1) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a penalty</u>
- 23 recovered under this section shall be deposited to the credit of the
- 24 Railroad Commission of Texas operating account established under
- 25 <u>Section 81.021.</u>
- 26 SECTION 7. Section 116.143, Natural Resources Code, is
- 27 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

- 1 (d) A penalty collected under this section shall be
- 2 deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 3 operating account established under Section 81.021.
- 4 SECTION 8. Section 117.051, Natural Resources Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 117.051. CIVIL PENALTY. (a) A person who violates
- 7 this chapter or a rule adopted by the commission under this chapter
- 8 is subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$50 nor more than
- 9 \$25,000 for each act of violation and for each day of violation,
- 10 provided that the maximum civil penalty that may be assessed for any
- 11 related series of violations may not exceed \$500,000.
- 12 (b) A penalty collected under this section shall be
- 13 deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 14 operating account established under Section 81.021.
- 15 SECTION 9. Section 134.178, Natural Resources Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 134.178. RECOVERY OF ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY. (a) The
- 18 attorney general at the request of the commission may bring a civil
- 19 action to recover an administrative penalty owed under this
- 20 chapter.
- 21 (b) An administrative penalty collected under this chapter
- 22 shall be deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 23 operating account established under Section 81.021.
- SECTION 10. Section 141.016, Natural Resources Code, is
- 25 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 141.016. RECOVERY OF PENALTY. Civil penalties owed
- 27 under Sections 141.013-141.015 [of this code] may be recovered in a

- 1 civil action brought by the attorney general at the request of the
- 2 commission and shall be deposited on collection to the credit of the
- 3 Railroad Commission of Texas operating account established under
- 4 Section 81.021.
- 5 SECTION 11. Section 105.027, Utilities Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 105.027. DISPOSITION OF FINES AND PENALTIES. A fine or
- 8 penalty collected under this subtitle, other than a fine or penalty
- 9 collected in a criminal proceeding, shall be <u>deposited to the</u>
- 10 credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas operating account
- 11 established under Section 81.021, Natural Resources Code [paid to
- 12 the railroad commission].
- 13 SECTION 12. Subchapter E, Chapter 121, Utilities Code, is
- 14 amended by adding Section 121.212 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 121.212. DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN PENALTIES. An
- 16 administrative or civil penalty collected under this subchapter
- 17 shall be deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 18 operating account established under Section 81.021, Natural
- 19 Resources Code.
- 20 SECTION 13. Subchapter G, Chapter 121, Utilities Code, is
- 21 amended by adding Section 121.311 to read as follows:
- Sec. 121.311. DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN PENALTIES. An
- 23 administrative or civil penalty collected under this subchapter
- 24 shall be deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 25 operating account established under Section 81.021, Natural
- 26 Resources Code.
- 27 SECTION 14. Section 27.101, Water Code, is amended by

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- 1 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 2 (c) A penalty collected under this section shall be
- 3 deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 4 operating account established under Section 81.021, Natural
- 5 Resources Code.
- 6 SECTION 15. Section 27.1014, Water Code, is amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 Sec. 27.1014. RECOVERY OF PENALTY. Civil penalties owed
- 9 under Sections 27.1011-27.1013 [of this code] may be recovered in a
- 10 civil action brought by the attorney general at the request of the
- 11 railroad commission and shall be deposited on collection to the
- 12 credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas operating account
- 13 <u>established under Section 81.021, Natural Resources Code</u>.
- 14 SECTION 16. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
