- 2 relating to the governing body and the powers of the Agua Special
- 3 Utility District.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 7201.052, Special District Local Laws
- 6 Code, is amended by amending Subsection (j) and adding Subsection
- 7 (k-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (j) A director may not serve more than two consecutive
- 9 terms. An initial appointment under Section 7201.051 constitutes
- 10 one term.
- 11 (k-1) A person who was appointed as an initial director
- 12 under Section 7201.051 is eligible to serve as an elected director.
- SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 7201.205, Special
- 14 District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 15 (a) The district may not disconnect service of a customer
- 16 for late payment before the 11th [31st] day after the date the
- 17 district notifies the customer of the overdue payment.
- 18 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 19 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 20 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 21 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 22 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 23 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 24 Government Code.

- 1 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 2 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 3 Environmental Quality.
- 4 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 5 its recommendations relating to this  $\operatorname{Act}$  with the governor, the
- 6 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 7 representatives within the required time.
- 8 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 9 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 10 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 11 and accomplished.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
