1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the governing body and the powers of the Agua Special  
1-11 Utility District.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 7201.052, Special District Local Laws  
1-14 Code, is amended by amending Subsection (j) and adding Subsection  
1-15 (k-1) to read as follows:

1-16 (j) A director may not serve more than two consecutive  
1-17 terms. An initial appointment under Section 7201.051 constitutes  
1-18 one term.

1-19 (k-1) A person who was appointed as an initial director  
1-20 under Section 7201.051 is eligible to serve as an elected director.

1-21 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 7201.205, Special  
1-22 District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-23 (a) The district may not disconnect service of a customer  
1-24 for late payment before the 11th [~~31st~~] day after the date the  
1-25 district notifies the customer of the overdue payment.

1-26 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to  
1-27 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this  
1-28 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a  
1-29 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,  
1-30 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished  
1-31 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,  
1-32 Government Code.

1-33 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has  
1-34 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on  
1-35 Environmental Quality.

1-36 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed  
1-37 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the  
1-38 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of  
1-39 representatives within the required time.

1-40 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this  
1-41 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect  
1-42 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled  
1-43 and accomplished.

1-44 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
