1-8 relating to the Fannin County Juvenile Board.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Section 152.0031, Human Resources Code, is
1-11 amended to read as follows:

1-12 Sec. 152.0031. APPLICATION OF SUBCHAPTER. Except as
1-13 otherwise provided by this chapter, this [This] subchapter does not
1-14 apply to a county that is served by a juvenile board created under
1-15 Subchapter C or D.

1-16 SECTION 2. Section 152.0801, Human Resources Code, is
1-17 amended to read as follows:

1-18 Sec. 152.0801. FANNIN COUNTY. [~~(a)~~] The Fannin County
1-19 Juvenile Board is governed by Subchapter B [~~composed of the county~~
1-20 ~~judge and the district judges in Fannin County~~].

1-21 [~~(b) The juvenile court judge is the chairman of the board~~
1-22 ~~and its chief administrative officer.~~

1-23 [~~(c) The county commissioners court may pay the juvenile~~
1-24 ~~board chairman additional annual compensation of \$1,200 for the~~
1-25 ~~added duties imposed on the chairman. The commissioners court may~~
1-26 ~~pay the other members of the board additional annual compensation~~
1-27 ~~of not more than \$1,200. The additional compensation shall be paid~~
1-28 ~~in equal monthly installments from the general fund or any other~~
1-29 ~~available fund of the county.~~

1-30 [~~(d) The commissioners court shall certify all claims for~~
1-31 ~~expenses of the juvenile probation officer as necessary in the~~
1-32 ~~performance of the officer's duties. The commissioners court shall~~
1-33 ~~provide the necessary funds to pay the salaries and expenses of the~~
1-34 ~~juvenile probation officer.~~

1-35 [~~(e) Sections 152.0002, 152.0004, 152.0005, 152.0006,~~
1-36 ~~152.0007, and 152.0008 do not apply to the juvenile board of Fannin~~
1-37 ~~County.~~]

1-38 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-39 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-40 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-41 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-42 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
