- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 24.139(b) and (d), Government Code, are
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (b) This section applies to the 37th, 45th, 57th, 73rd,
- 7 131st, 144th, 150th, 166th, 175th, 186th, 187th, 224th, 225th,
- 8 226th, 227th, 285th, 288th, 289th, [and] 290th, 379th, 386th,
- 9 399th, 407th, 408th, 436th, 437th, and 438th district courts in
- 10 Bexar County.
- 11 (d) The 144th, 175th, 186th, 187th, 226th, 227th, [and]
- 12 290th, 379th, 399th, and 437th district courts shall give
- 13 preference to criminal cases. The terms of those courts begin on
- 14 the first Mondays in January and July. Each term continues until
- 15 the court has disposed of the business for that term.
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 24.524, Government Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 24.524. 379TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (BEXAR COUNTY). (a)
- 19 The 379th Judicial District is composed of Bexar County.
- 20 (b) The 379th District Court shall give preference to
- 21 <u>criminal matters.</u>
- SECTION 3. Sections 24.139(g) and (h), Government Code, are
- 23 repealed.
