

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the creation of the Vintage Municipal Management District; providing authority to impose a tax, levy an assessment, and issue bonds.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 4, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Chapter 3908 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 3908. VINTAGE MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT DISTRICT

SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Sec. 3908.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.

(2) "City" means the City of Houston, Texas.

(3) "Director" means a board member.

(4) "District" means the Vintage Municipal Management District.

Sec. 3908.002. CREATION AND NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a special district created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

Sec. 3908.003. PURPOSE; LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS. (a) The creation of the district is essential to accomplish the purposes of Sections 52 and 52-a, Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and other public purposes stated in this chapter. By creating the district and in authorizing the city and other political subdivisions to contract with the district, the

1 legislature has established a program to accomplish the public
2 purposes set out in Section 52-a, Article III, Texas Constitution.

3 (b) The creation of the district is necessary to promote,
4 develop, encourage, and maintain employment, commerce,
5 transportation, housing, tourism, recreation, the arts,
6 entertainment, economic development, safety, and the public
7 welfare in the district.

8 (c) The district is created to supplement and not to
9 supplant city services provided in the district.

10 Sec. 3908.004. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE. (a)
11 The district is created to serve a public use and benefit.

12 (b) All land and other property included in the district
13 will benefit from the improvements and services to be provided by
14 the district under powers conferred by Sections 52 and 52-a,
15 Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and
16 other powers granted under this chapter.

17 (c) The creation of the district is in the public interest
18 and is essential to further the public purposes of:

19 (1) developing and diversifying the economy of the
20 state;

21 (2) eliminating unemployment and underemployment;

22 (3) developing or expanding transportation and
23 commerce; and

24 (4) providing quality residential housing.

25 (d) The district will:

26 (1) promote the health, safety, and general welfare of
27 residents, employers, potential employees, employees, visitors,

1 and consumers in the district, and of the public;

2 (2) provide needed funding for the district to
3 preserve, maintain, and enhance the economic health and vitality of
4 the district territory as a residential community and business
5 center; and

6 (3) promote the health, safety, welfare, and enjoyment
7 of the public by providing pedestrian ways and by landscaping and
8 developing certain areas in the district, which are necessary for
9 the restoration, preservation, and enhancement of scenic beauty.

10 (e) Pedestrian ways along or across a street, whether at
11 grade or above or below the surface, and street lighting, street
12 landscaping, vehicle parking, and street art objects are parts of
13 and necessary components of a street and are considered to be an
14 improvement project that includes a street or road improvement.

15 (f) The district will not act as the agent or
16 instrumentality of any private interest even though the district
17 will benefit many private interests as well as the public.

18 Sec. 3908.005. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
19 district is initially composed of the territory described by
20 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.

21 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
22 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake in the
23 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
24 does not affect the district's:

25 (1) organization, existence, or validity;

26 (2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes
27 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and

1 interest on the bond;

2 (3) right to impose or collect an assessment or tax; or

3 (4) legality or operation.

4 Sec. 3908.006. ELIGIBILITY FOR INCLUSION IN SPECIAL ZONES.

5 (a) All or any part of the area of the district is eligible to be
6 included in:

7 (1) a tax increment reinvestment zone created under
8 Chapter 311, Tax Code;

9 (2) a tax abatement reinvestment zone created under
10 Chapter 312, Tax Code;

11 (3) an enterprise zone created under Chapter 2303,
12 Government Code; or

13 (4) an industrial district created under Chapter 42,
14 Local Government Code.

15 (b) If the city creates a tax increment reinvestment zone
16 described by Subsection (a), the city and the board of directors of
17 the zone, by contract with the district, may grant money deposited
18 in the tax increment fund to the district to be used by the district
19 for the purposes permitted for money granted to a corporation under
20 Section 380.002(b), Local Government Code, including the right to
21 pledge the money as security for any bonds issued by the district
22 for an improvement project. A project may not receive public funds
23 under Section 380.002(b), Local Government Code, unless the project
24 has been approved by the governing body of the city.

25 (c) A tax increment reinvestment zone created by the city in
26 the district is not subject to the limitations provided by Section
27 311.006(b), Tax Code.

1 Sec. 3908.007. APPLICABILITY OF MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT
2 DISTRICTS LAW. Except as otherwise provided by this chapter,
3 Chapter 375, Local Government Code, applies to the district.

4 Sec. 3908.008. LIBERAL CONSTRUCTION OF CHAPTER. This
5 chapter shall be liberally construed in conformity with the
6 findings and purposes stated in this chapter.

7 [Sections 3908.009-3908.050 reserved for expansion]

8 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

9 Sec. 3908.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. The district is
10 governed by a board of five directors who serve staggered terms of
11 four years expiring June 1 of each even-numbered year.

12 Sec. 3908.052. QUALIFICATIONS OF DIRECTORS APPOINTED BY
13 CITY. (a) To be qualified to serve as a director appointed by the
14 governing body of the city, a person must be:

15 (1) a resident of the district who is also a registered
16 voter of the district;

17 (2) an owner of property in the district;

18 (3) an owner of stock or a partnership or membership
19 interest, whether beneficial or otherwise, of a corporate
20 partnership, limited liability company, or other entity owner of a
21 direct or indirect interest in property in the district;

22 (4) an owner of a beneficial interest in a trust, or a
23 trustee in a trust, that directly or indirectly owns property in the
24 district; or

25 (5) an agent, employee, or tenant of a person
26 described by Subdivision (2), (3), or (4).

27 (b) Section 49.052, Water Code, does not apply to the

1 district.

2 Sec. 3908.053. APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS. The governing
3 body of the city shall appoint directors from persons recommended
4 by the board.

5 Sec. 3908.054. VACANCY. If a vacancy occurs on the board,
6 the remaining directors shall appoint a director for the remainder
7 of the unexpired term.

8 Sec. 3908.055. DIRECTOR'S OATH OR AFFIRMATION. (a) A
9 director shall file the director's oath or affirmation of office
10 with the district, and the district shall retain the oath or
11 affirmation in the district records.

12 (b) A director shall file a copy of the director's oath or
13 affirmation with the secretary of the city.

14 Sec. 3908.056. OFFICERS. The board shall elect from among
15 the directors a chair, a vice chair, and a secretary. The offices
16 of chair and secretary may not be held by the same person.

17 Sec. 3908.057. COMPENSATION; EXPENSES. (a) The district
18 may compensate each director in an amount not to exceed \$50 for each
19 board meeting. The total amount of compensation for each director
20 in one year may not exceed \$2,000.

21 (b) A director is entitled to reimbursement for necessary
22 and reasonable expenses incurred in carrying out the duties and
23 responsibilities of the board.

24 Sec. 3908.058. LIABILITY INSURANCE. The district may
25 obtain and pay for comprehensive general liability insurance
26 coverage from a commercial insurance company or other source that
27 protects and insures a director against personal liability and from

1 all claims relating to:

2 (1) actions taken by the director in the director's
3 capacity as a member of the board;

4 (2) actions and activities taken by the district; or

5 (3) the actions of others acting on behalf of the
6 district.

7 Sec. 3908.059. NO EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. The board may not
8 create an executive committee to exercise the powers of the board.

9 Sec. 3908.060. BOARD MEETINGS. The board shall hold
10 meetings at a place accessible to the public.

11 Sec. 3908.061. INITIAL DIRECTORS. (a) The initial board
12 consists of:

18 (b) The terms of the initial directors expire June 1, 2012.

19 (c) Of the directors who replace an initial director, the
20 terms of directors serving in positions 1, 2, and 3 expire June 1,
21 2014, and the terms of directors serving in positions 4 and 5 expire
22 June 1, 2016.

23 (d) Section 3908.052 does not apply to this section.

24 (e) This section expires September 1, 2012.

25 [Sections 3908.062-3908.100 reserved for expansion]

26 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

1 Sec. 3908.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has
2 the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for
3 which the district is created.

4 Sec. 3908.102. IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND SERVICES. (a) The
5 district may provide, design, construct, acquire, improve,
6 relocate, operate, maintain, or finance an improvement project or
7 service using money available to the district, or contract with a
8 governmental or private entity to provide, design, construct,
9 acquire, improve, relocate, operate, maintain, or finance an
10 improvement project or service authorized under this chapter or
11 Chapter 375, Local Government Code.

12 (b) An improvement project described by Subsection (a) may
13 be located:

14 (1) in the district; or

15 (2) in an area outside but adjacent to the district if
16 the project is for the purpose of extending a public infrastructure
17 improvement beyond the district's boundaries to a logical terminus.

18 Sec. 3908.103. DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION POWERS. The
19 district, using money available to the district, may exercise the
20 powers given to a development corporation under Chapter 505, Local
21 Government Code, including the power to own, operate, acquire,
22 construct, lease, improve, or maintain a project under that
23 chapter.

24 Sec. 3908.104. NONPROFIT CORPORATION. (a) The board by
25 resolution may authorize the creation of a nonprofit corporation to
26 assist and act for the district in implementing a project or
27 providing a service authorized by this chapter.

1 (b) The nonprofit corporation:

2 (1) has each power of and is considered to be a local
3 government corporation created under Subchapter D, Chapter 431,
4 Transportation Code; and

5 (2) may implement any project and provide any service
6 authorized by this chapter.

7 (c) The board shall appoint the board of directors of the
8 nonprofit corporation. The board of directors of the nonprofit
9 corporation shall serve in the same manner as the board of directors
10 of a local government corporation created under Subchapter D,
11 Chapter 431, Transportation Code, except that a board member is not
12 required to reside in the district.

13 Sec. 3908.105. AGREEMENTS; GRANTS. (a) As provided by
14 Chapter 375, Local Government Code, the district may make an
15 agreement with or accept a gift, grant, or loan from any person.

16 (b) The implementation of a project is a governmental
17 function or service for the purposes of Chapter 791, Government
18 Code.

19 Sec. 3908.106. LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES. To protect the
20 public interest, the district may contract with a qualified party,
21 including Harris County or the city, to provide law enforcement
22 services in the district for a fee.

23 Sec. 3908.107. MEMBERSHIP IN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS. The
24 district may join and pay dues to a charitable or nonprofit
25 organization that performs a service or provides an activity
26 consistent with the furtherance of a district purpose.

27 Sec. 3908.108. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. (a) The district may

1 engage in activities that accomplish the economic development
2 purposes of the district.

3 (b) The district may establish and provide for the
4 administration of one or more programs to promote state or local
5 economic development and to stimulate business and commercial
6 activity in the district, including programs to:

7 (1) make loans and grants of public money; and

8 (2) provide district personnel and services.

9 (c) The district may create economic development programs
10 and exercise the economic development powers that:

11 (1) Chapter 380, Local Government Code, provides to a
12 municipality; and

13 (2) Subchapter A, Chapter 1509, Government Code,
14 provides to a municipality.

15 Sec. 3908.109. PARKING FACILITIES. (a) The district may
16 acquire, lease as lessor or lessee, construct, develop, own,
17 operate, and maintain parking facilities or a system of parking
18 facilities, including lots, garages, parking terminals, or other
19 structures or accommodations for parking motor vehicles off the
20 streets and related appurtenances.

21 (b) The district's parking facilities serve the public
22 purposes of the district and are owned, used, and held for a public
23 purpose even if leased or operated by a private entity for a term of
24 years.

25 (c) The district's parking facilities are necessary
26 components of a street and are considered to be a street or road
27 improvement.

1 (d) The development and operation of the district's parking
2 facilities may be considered an economic development program.

3 Sec. 3908.110. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may
4 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

5 [Sections 3908.111-3908.150 reserved for expansion]

6 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS; ASSESSMENTS

7 Sec. 3908.151. DISBURSEMENTS AND TRANSFERS OF MONEY. The
8 board by resolution shall establish the number of signatures and
9 the procedure required for a disbursement or transfer of the
10 district's money.

11 Sec. 3908.152. MONEY USED FOR IMPROVEMENTS OR SERVICES.
12 The district may acquire, construct, finance, operate, or maintain
13 an improvement project or service authorized under this chapter or
14 Chapter 375, Local Government Code, using any money available to
15 the district.

16 Sec. 3908.153. PETITION REQUIRED FOR FINANCING SERVICES AND
17 IMPROVEMENTS WITH ASSESSMENTS. (a) The board may not finance a
18 service or improvement project with assessments under this chapter
19 unless a written petition requesting that service or improvement
20 has been filed with the board.

21 (b) A petition filed under Subsection (a) must be signed by:

22 (1) the owners of a majority of the assessed value of
23 real property in the district subject to assessment according to
24 the most recent certified tax appraisal roll for Harris County; or

25 (2) at least 25 persons who own real property in the
26 district subject to assessment, if more than 25 persons own real
27 property in the district subject to assessment as determined by the

1 most recent certified tax appraisal roll for Harris County.

2 Sec. 3908.154. METHOD OF NOTICE FOR HEARING. The district
3 may mail the notice required by Section 375.115(c), Local
4 Government Code, by certified or first class United States mail.
5 The board shall determine the method of notice.

6 Sec. 3908.155. ASSESSMENTS; LIENS FOR ASSESSMENTS. (a)
7 The board by resolution may impose and collect an assessment for any
8 purpose authorized by this chapter in all or any part of the
9 district.

10 (b) An assessment, a reassessment, or an assessment
11 resulting from an addition to or correction of the assessment roll
12 by the district, penalties and interest on an assessment or
13 reassessment, an expense of collection, and reasonable attorney's
14 fees incurred by the district:

15 (1) are a first and prior lien against the property
16 assessed;

17 (2) are superior to any other lien or claim other than
18 a lien or claim for county, school district, or municipal ad valorem
19 taxes; and

20 (3) are the personal liability of and a charge against
21 the owners of the property even if the owners are not named in the
22 assessment proceedings.

23 (c) The lien is effective from the date of the board's
24 resolution imposing the assessment until the date the assessment is
25 paid. The board may enforce the lien in the same manner that the
26 board may enforce an ad valorem tax lien against real property.

27 (d) The board may make a correction to or deletion from the

1 assessment roll that does not increase the amount of assessment of
2 any parcel of land without providing notice and holding a hearing in
3 the manner required for additional assessments.

4 Sec. 3908.156. TAX AND ASSESSMENT ABATEMENTS. The district
5 may designate reinvestment zones and may grant abatements of a tax
6 or assessment on property in the zones.

7 [Sections 3908.157-3908.200 reserved for expansion]

8 SUBCHAPTER E. TAXES AND BONDS

9 Sec. 3908.201. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS. (a) The
10 district may issue, by public or private sale, bonds, notes, or
11 other obligations payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes or
12 assessments in the manner provided by Subchapter A, Chapter 372, or
13 Subchapter J, Chapter 375, Local Government Code.

14 (b) In exercising the district's borrowing power, the
15 district may issue a bond or other obligation in the form of a bond,
16 note, certificate of participation or other instrument evidencing a
17 proportionate interest in payments to be made by the district, or
18 other type of obligation.

19 (c) In addition to the sources of money described by
20 Subchapter A, Chapter 372, and Subchapter J, Chapter 375, Local
21 Government Code, district bonds may be secured and made payable
22 wholly or partly by a pledge of any part of the money the district
23 receives from improvement revenue or from any other source.

24 Sec. 3908.202. BOND MATURITY. Bonds may mature not more
25 than 40 years from their date of issue.

26 Sec. 3908.203. TAXES FOR BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS. At
27 the time bonds or other obligations payable wholly or partly from ad

1 valorem taxes are issued:

2 (1) the board shall impose a continuing direct annual
3 ad valorem tax for each year that all or part of the bonds are
4 outstanding; and

5 (2) the district annually shall impose an ad valorem
6 tax on all taxable property in the district in an amount sufficient
7 to:

8 (A) pay the interest on the bonds or other
9 obligations as the interest becomes due; and

10 (B) create a sinking fund for the payment of the
11 principal of the bonds or other obligations when due or the
12 redemption price at any earlier required redemption date.

13 [Sections 3908.204-3908.250 reserved for expansion]

14 SUBCHAPTER F. DISSOLUTION

15 Sec. 3908.251. DISSOLUTION BY CITY ORDINANCE. (a) The city
16 by ordinance may dissolve the district.

17 (b) The city may not dissolve the district until the
18 district's outstanding debt or contractual obligations that are
19 payable from ad valorem taxes have been repaid or discharged, or the
20 city has affirmatively assumed the obligation to pay the
21 outstanding debt from city revenue.

22 Sec. 3908.252. COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS AND OTHER REVENUE.

23 (a) If the dissolved district has bonds or other obligations
24 outstanding secured by and payable from assessments or other
25 revenue, other than ad valorem taxes, the city shall succeed to the
26 rights and obligations of the district regarding enforcement and
27 collection of the assessments or other revenue.

1 (b) The city shall have and exercise all district powers to
2 enforce and collect the assessments or other revenue to pay:

3 (1) the bonds or other obligations when due and
4 payable according to their terms; or

5 (2) special revenue or assessment bonds or other
6 obligations issued by the city to refund the outstanding bonds or
7 obligations.

8 Sec. 3908.253. CONCURRENCE ON ADDITIONAL POWERS. If the
9 legislature grants the district a power that is in addition to the
10 powers approved by the initial resolution of the governing body of
11 the city consenting to the creation of the district, the district
12 may not exercise that power unless the governing body of the city
13 consents to that change by resolution.

14 Sec. 3908.254. ASSUMPTION OF ASSETS AND LIABILITIES. (a)
15 After the city dissolves the district, the city assumes, subject to
16 the appropriation and availability of funds, the obligations of the
17 district, including any bonds or other debt payable from
18 assessments or other district revenue.

19 (b) If the city dissolves the district, the board shall
20 transfer ownership of all district property to the city.

21 SECTION 2. The Vintage Municipal Management District

3 tract as recorded under Harris County Clerk's File No. (H.C.C.F.
4 No.) X616317, said 3.087 acre tract being more particularly
5 described by metes and bounds as follows:

6 BEGINNING at a 5/8-inch iron rod w/cap "Terra Surveying" found for
7 the common southeast corner of said 168.51 acre tract and the herein
8 described tract, lying in the north right-of-way line of Louetta
9 Road (width varies) as recorded under H.C.C.F. Nos. H467527 thru
10 H467530 and M825809 and lying in the west right-of-way line of the
11 Texas and Brazos Valley Railway Co. (100 feet wide);

12 THENCE S 50°50'10" W, 167.60 feet along the north right-of-way line
13 of said Louetta Road to a 5/8-inch iron rod w/cap "Terra Surveying"
14 found for a corner of the herein described tract;

16 right-of-way line of said Louetta Road to a 1/2-inch iron pipe with
17 cap stamped BROWN & GAY found for the most southerly southeast

20 THENCE, leaving the north right-of-way line of said Louetta Road
21 and along the eastern right-of-way lines of Vintage Preserve

24 right a distance of 38.83 feet, having a radius of 25.00 feet
25 and a central angle of 89°00'00", with a chord bearing N
26 78°39'26" W, 35.05 feet to a 1/2-inch iron pipe with cap
27 stamped BROWN & GAY found for the point of tangency;

1 N 34°09'26" W, 345.00 feet to a 1/2-inch iron pipe with cap
2 stamped BROWN & GAY found for the northwest corner of the
3 herein described tract and being in a southern line of said
4 VINTAGE ROYALE SEC. 1;

5 THENCE N 55°50'34" E, 387.04 feet along said southern line to a point

21 No.) X616317, said 8.916 acre tract being more particularly
22 described by metes and bounds as follows:

23 BEGINNING at a 5/8-inch iron rod w/cap "Brown & Gay" found for the
24 southeast corner of a called 3.658 acre tract described as 10130 LC
25 ProMed DEVELOPMENT as shown on the plat recorded under Film Code No.
26 615059 of the Harris County Map Records (H.C.M.R.) and being the
27 southwest corner of the herein described tract and lying in the

1 north right-of-way line of Louetta Road (width varies) as recorded
2 under H.C.C.F. Nos. H467527 thru H467530 and M825809;

3 THENCE N 44°17'48" W, 442.88 feet along the east line of said 3.658
4 acre tract to a 5/8-inch iron rod with cap stamped BROWN & GAY found
5 for the northeast corner of said 3.658 acre tract and the most
6 westerly corner of the herein described tract;

7 THENCE N 87°40'30" E, 162.99 feet to the most westerly southwest
8 corner of VINTAGE ROYALE SEC. 1 as shown on the plat recorded under
9 Film Code No. 619098 of the H.C.M.R.;

10 THENCE N 55°50'34" E, 992.55 feet to along a southern line of said
11 VINTAGE ROYALE SEC. 1 to a 1/2-inch iron pipe with cap stamped BROWN
12 & GAY found for the northeast corner of the herein described tract
13 and being in the western right-of-way line of Vintage Preserve
14 Parkway (100-foot wide);

15 THENCE along said western right-of-way line the following two (2)
16 courses:

17 S 34°09'26" E, 344.31 feet to a 1/2-inch iron pipe with cap
18 stamped BROWN & GAY found for the point of curvature of a
19 curve to the right;

20 In a southerly direction, along the arc of said curve to the
21 right a distance of 39.50 feet, having a radius of 25.00 feet
22 and a central angle of 90°31'52", with a chord bearing S

16 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
17 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
18 Environmental Quality.

19 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
20 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor,
21 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives
22 within the required time.

23 (d) The general law relating to consent by political
24 subdivisions to the creation of districts with conservation,
25 reclamation, and road powers and the inclusion of land in those
26 districts has been complied with.

27 (e) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this

2 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act have been
