1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to compensation for services and reimbursement for
1-9 expenses of a member of the board of directors of the Lake View
1-10 Management and Development District.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 3828.056, Special District Local Laws
1-13 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 3828.056. COMPENSATION. (a) In this section,
1-15 "performing the duties of a director" means substantive performance
1-16 of the management or business of the district, including
1-17 participation in board and committee meetings and other activities
1-18 involving the substantive deliberation of district business and in
1-19 pertinent educational programs. The term does not include routine
1-20 or ministerial activities such as the execution of documents,
1-21 self-preparation for meetings, or other activities requiring a
1-22 minimal amount of time.

1-23 (b) A director is ~~[not]~~ entitled to receive fees of office
1-24 of not more than \$150 a day for each day the director spends
1-25 performing the duties of a director as compensation for service on
1-26 the board and ~~[but]~~ is entitled to reimbursement for necessary and
1-27 reasonable expenses incurred in performing ~~[carrying out]~~ the
1-28 duties ~~[and responsibilities]~~ of a director.

1-29 (c) The board by resolution shall set a limit on the fees of
1-30 office that a director may receive in a year. The board may not set
1-31 the limit at more than \$7,200.

1-32 (d) To receive compensation or reimbursement for expenses,
1-33 a director must file with the district a verified statement showing
1-34 the number of days spent performing the duties of a director and a
1-35 general description of the duties performed for each day of
1-36 service.

1-37 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
1-38 the compensation and reimbursement for expenses of a member of the
1-39 board of directors of the Lake View Management and Development
1-40 District for the performance of duties on or after the effective
1-41 date of this Act. The compensation or reimbursement for expenses
1-42 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
1-43 effect when the duty is performed, and the former law is continued
1-44 in effect for that purpose.

1-45 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
1-46 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
1-47 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
1-48 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
1-49 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
1-50 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
1-51 Government Code.

1-52 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
1-53 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
1-54 Environmental Quality.

1-55 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
1-56 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor,
1-57 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives
1-58 within the required time.

1-59 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
1-60 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
1-61 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act have been
1-62 fulfilled and accomplished.

1-63 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-64 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

2-1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-3 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
