A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the ability to exclude certain territory from the
- 3 Hamlin Hospital District.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 1037, Special District Local Laws Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Subchapter G to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER G. CHANGE IN BOUNDARIES
- 8 Sec. 1037.301. PETITION TO EXCLUDE TERRITORY FROM DISTRICT.
- 9 (a) Registered voters of a defined territory included in the
- 10 district may file a petition with the board requesting that the
- 11 defined territory be excluded from the district.
- 12 (b) The petition must be signed by at least 50 registered
- 13 voters of the territory or a majority of those voters, whichever is
- 14 fewer.
- Sec. 1037.302. NOTICE OF HEARING. (a) The board by order
- 16 shall set a time and place to hold a hearing on a petition to exclude
- 17 a defined territory from the district.
- 18 (b) The hearing shall be held at least 30 days after the date
- 19 the board issues the order.
- 20 <u>(c) The board shall notify the governing body of the</u>
- 21 territory to be excluded of the hearing.
- Sec. 1037.303. ORDER OF EXCLUSION. (a) If, after a hearing
- 23 under Section 1037.302, the board and the governing body of the
- 24 territory to be excluded determine that exclusion of the territory

- 1 from the district would benefit the district, the board and the
- 2 governing body may approve the exclusion by a resolution entered in
- 3 their minutes.
- 4 (b) The board and the governing body of the territory to be
- 5 excluded are not required to exclude all territory described in the
- 6 petition if the board and the governing body find that excluding
- 7 only a portion of the territory is necessary or desirable.
- 8 Sec. 1037.304. RATIFICATION ELECTION. (a) Exclusion of
- 9 territory is final when approved by a majority of the voters at:
- 10 (1) an election held in the district; and
- 11 (2) a separate election held in the territory to be
- 12 excluded.
- 13 (b) The election shall be held not earlier than the 45th day
- 14 and not later than the 60th day after the date the election is
- 15 <u>ordered.</u>
- 16 <u>(c) The election may be called by the governing body of the</u>
- 17 territory to be excluded on its own motion.
- 18 (d) The election order must state:
- 19 (1) the nature of the election, including the
- 20 proposition to appear on the ballot;
- 21 (2) the date of the election;
- 22 (3) the hours during which the polls will be open; and
- 23 (4) the location of the polling places.
- (e) Section 41.001(a), Election Code, does not apply to an
- 25 election held under this section.
- Sec. 1037.305. NOTICE OF RATIFICATION ELECTION. (a) The
- 27 governing body of the territory to be excluded shall give notice of

- 1 an election under Section 1037.304 by publishing once a week for two
- 2 consecutive weeks a substantial copy of the election order in a
- 3 newspaper with general circulation in:
- 4 (1) the district; and
- 5 (2) the territory proposed to be excluded from the
- 6 district.
- 7 (b) The first publication of the notice must appear at least
- 8 35 days before the date of the election.
- 9 Sec. 1037.306. BALLOT. The ballot for an election under
- 10 Section 1037.304 shall be printed to permit voting for or against
- 11 the proposition: "Excluding (description of territory to be
- 12 excluded) from the Hamlin Hospital District."
- 13 Sec. 1037.307. SATISFACTION OF PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF DEBT.
- 14 The exclusion of territory under this subchapter does not diminish
- 15 or impair the rights of the holders of any outstanding and unpaid
- 16 bonds, warrants, or other district obligations. The district shall
- 17 continue to impose taxes each year on the excluded territory at the
- 18 same rate imposed on other territory in the district until the total
- 19 amount of taxes collected from the excluded territory equals its
- 20 pro rata share of the indebtedness of the district at the time the
- 21 territory was excluded. The taxes collected under this section
- 22 shall be applied only to the payment of the excluded territory's pro
- 23 rata share of indebtedness. The owner of all or part of the
- 24 excluded territory at any time may pay in full the owner's share of
- 25 the excluded territory's pro rata share of the district's
- 26 indebtedness at the time the territory was excluded.
- Sec. 1037.308. EXCLUSION ORDER. After the territory to be

- 1 <u>excluded has paid its proportionate share of the district debt, the</u>
- 2 board shall enter a resolution in its minutes excluding the
- 3 territory from the district and releasing the excluded territory
- 4 from any further duty or obligation.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
