5	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 11, Local Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 354 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 354. EMERGENCY SERVICES IN RURAL COUNTIES
8	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
9	Sec. 354.001. APPLICABILITY. This chapter applies only to
10	a county with:
11	(1) a population of less than 20,000 that is adjacent
12	to a county with an international border;
13	(2) a state park; and
14	(3) an interstate highway.

16	SUBCHAPTER B. STATE PARKS
17	Sec. 354.051. ADMISSION TO PARK; USE OF MONEY FOR EMERGENCY
18	SERVICES. (a) The Parks and Wildlife Department shall use \$1 from
19	the admission to a state park in the county for the purposes
20	described by this section. Revenue collected under this section
21	and deposited in the state parks account under Section 11.035,
22	Parks and Wildlife Code, may be appropriated only to the department
23	to award grants to a county that provides emergency services that
24	directly or indirectly benefit the park.

(b) The county shall use the money to pay for emergency
services provided by the county in the county, including emergency
services provided by volunteers.

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
