## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-8 relating to the authority of a general-law municipality to annex 1-9 territory receiving water and sewer services from a municipal 1-10 1-11 utility district.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 43.033, Local Government Code. is amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 1-13

(c) Subsection (a) (3) does not apply to a municipality that annexes an area that receives water and sewer service from a municipal utility district that provides water and sewer service to 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 all or part of the municipality. 1-17

SECTION 2. Section 43.033, Local Government 1-18 Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to an annexation of an area for which a municipality institutes proceedings to annex the area on or 1-19 1-20 1-21 after the effective date of this Act. The annexation of an area for 1-22 which a municipality institutes annexation proceedings before that date is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in 1-23 1-24 1**-**25 1**-**26 effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-28 1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-30 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
