1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the authority of a general-law municipality to annex
1-9 territory receiving water and sewer services from a municipal
1-10 utility district.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 43.033, Local Government Code, is
1-13 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-14 (c) Subsection (a)(3) does not apply to a municipality that
1-15 annexes an area that receives water and sewer service from a
1-16 municipal utility district that provides water and sewer service to
1-17 all or part of the municipality.

1-18 SECTION 2. Section 43.033, Local Government Code, as
1-19 amended by this Act, applies only to an annexation of an area for
1-20 which a municipality institutes proceedings to annex the area on or
1-21 after the effective date of this Act. The annexation of an area for
1-22 which a municipality institutes annexation proceedings before that
1-23 date is governed by the law in effect immediately before the
1-24 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
1-25 effect for that purpose.

1-26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-28 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-30 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
