1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to an African American Texans memorial monument on the  
1-9 Capitol grounds.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Chapter 443, Government Code, is amended by  
1-12 adding Section 443.01526 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 443.01526. AFRICAN AMERICAN TEXANS MONUMENT. The  
1-14 State Preservation Board shall establish an African American Texans  
1-15 memorial monument on the State Capitol grounds that pays tribute to  
1-16 the contributions of African Americans to the State of Texas.

1-17 SECTION 2. Subsection (a-1), Section 443.0152, Government  
1-18 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-19 (a-1) Except as provided by Sections 443.01525 and  
1-20 443.01526 [~~448.034~~], after September 1, 2009, no additional  
1-21 monuments may be placed on the historic grounds of the Capitol.

1-22 SECTION 3. Chapter 448, Government Code, is repealed.

1-23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
