A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment revising the order of
- 2 legislative business to permit either house to act on bills and
- 3 resolutions after the first 30 days of a regular session.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 5(b), Article III, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) When convened in regular <u>session</u> [Session], the first
- 8 thirty days thereof shall be devoted to the introduction of bills
- 9 and resolutions, acting upon emergency appropriations, passing
- 10 upon the confirmation of the recess appointees of the Governor $\underline{\, \prime \,}$ and
- 11 such emergency matters as may be submitted by the Governor in
- 12 special messages to the Legislature. During the <u>remainder</u>
- 13 [succeeding thirty days] of the regular session $_{\underline{\prime}}$ [of the
- 14 Legislature] the various committees of each House shall hold
- 15 hearings to consider all bills $\underline{\prime}$ [and] resolutions $\underline{\prime}$ and other
- 16 matters then pending [+] and such emergency matters as may be
- 17 submitted by the Governor, and [. During the remainder of the
- 18 session] the Legislature shall act upon such bills and resolutions
- 19 as may be then pending and upon such emergency matters as may be
- 20 submitted by the Governor in special messages to the Legislature.
- 21 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 22 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011.
- 23 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 24 proposition: "The constitutional amendment revising the order of
