SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 proposing a constitutional amendment to change the length of the 3 unexpired term that causes the automatic resignation of certain 4 elected county or district officeholders if they become candidates 5 for another office.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 65, Article XVI, Texas
Constitution, is amended to read as follows:

9 (b) If any of the officers named herein shall announce their candidacy, or shall in fact become a candidate, in any General, 10 Special or Primary Election, for any office of profit or trust under 11 the laws of this State or the United States other than the office 12 then held, at any time when the unexpired term of the office then 13 held shall exceed one [(1)] year and 30 days, such announcement or 14 such candidacy shall constitute an automatic resignation of the 15 office then held, and the vacancy thereby created shall be filled 16 pursuant to law in the same manner as other vacancies for such 17 office are filled. 18

19 SECTION 2. (a) This proposed constitutional amendment 20 shall be submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 21 8, 2011, only if the secretary of state certifies that an enactment 22 of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, that became law provides 23 for a filing deadline for an application for a place on the general 24 primary ballot that occurs in the calendar year before the year in

which the primary is held. If the secretary of state does not make a 1 2 certification under this subsection, this resolution has no effect. (b) If the election on this amendment is held, the ballot 3 shall be printed to permit voting for or against the proposition: 4 5 "The constitutional amendment to change the length of the unexpired term that causes the automatic resignation of certain elected 6 7 county or district officeholders if they become candidates for another office." 8
