A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment revising the order of 2 legislative business to permit either house to act on bills and 3 resolutions after the first 15 days of a regular session.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 5(b), Article III, Texas Constitution, 6 is amended to read as follows:

7 (b) When convened in regular <u>session</u> [Session], the first <u>15</u> [thirty] days thereof shall be devoted to the introduction of bills 8 9 and resolutions, acting upon emergency appropriations, passing upon the confirmation of the recess appointees of the Governor and 10 11 such emergency matters as may be submitted by the Governor in 12 special messages to the Legislature. During the <u>remainder</u> [succeeding thirty days] of the regular session, [of the 13 14 Legislature] the various committees of each House shall hold hearings to consider all bills<u>, [and]</u> resolutions, and other 15 matters then pending[+] and such emergency matters as may be 16 submitted by the Governor, and [. During the remainder of the 17 session] the Legislature shall act upon such bills and resolutions 18 as may be then pending and upon such emergency matters as may be 19 20 submitted by the Governor in special messages to the Legislature.

21 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 22 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2011. 23 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 24 proposition: "The constitutional amendment revising the order of
