WHEREAS, Leadership Keller is an eight-month program that brings together a small group of area professionals for an intensive study of the various aspects of the Keller community; and

WHEREAS, The goals of this outstanding program include providing participants with a unique educational experience and helping them to develop their leadership skills; the program also aims to motivate emerging leaders and help them to acquire a working knowledge of the community; and

WHEREAS, Participants take backstage and behind-the-scenes tours of local schools, hospitals, community service agencies, city offices, entertainment venues, and police and fire departments to learn about the different sectors of the community; and

WHEREAS, The program also includes meetings with local officials and political leaders and a trip to Austin, where participants meet with elected leaders, state personnel, and agency department heads; and

WHEREAS, Through the Leadership Keller program, participants learn about the inner workings of private and public institutions and discover ways in which they can most effectively contribute to the betterment of their community; now, therefore, be it
