

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 640

WHEREAS, The Senate of the State of Texas is pleased to recognize Captain James P. Fleming for his exemplary service to the nation as a member of the United States Air Force during the Vietnam War; and

WHEREAS, The Vietnam War was one of the longest military conflicts in United States history; more than three million Americans served in Southeast Asia during the war, with more than 58,000 making the ultimate sacrifice, including more than 3,400 Texans; and

WHEREAS, Captain Fleming distinguished himself during this conflict through his exemplary courage; as aircraft commander of a UH-1F transport helicopter, he executed an extremely hazardous rescue of a special forces team pinned down by a much larger enemy force; for his conspicuous gallantry above and beyond the call of duty, he was awarded the Medal of Honor; and

WHEREAS, The men and women who served the nation during the Vietnam War embodied the highest standards of courage, sacrifice, and devotion to duty, and Captain Fleming's heroic actions set a lasting example that will live forever in the annals of American history; and

WHEREAS, It is truly fitting that this brave man be recognized for his patriotism and his service on behalf of the nation as Texans across the state observe Vietnam Veterans Day; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 82nd Legislature, hereby commend Captain James P. Fleming on his
