WHEREAS, He was a devoted husband, a gentle and caring father and grandfather, and a loving uncle; his family and his many friends will long remember his deep affection for his family, his love of music, his amazing sense of humor, his endless supply of stories, and his timely and impeccable counsel; and

WHEREAS, His loss brought great sadness to those who love him still, but the love he shared, the lessons he taught, and the memories he left behind will remain in the hearts of his family and friends for years to come; now, therefore, be it
