

Suspending limitations on conference committee
jurisdiction, H.B. No. 3726 (Guillen/Van de Putte)

R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Texas, 82nd
2 Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, That Senate Rule 12.03 be
3 suspended in part as provided by Senate Rule 12.08 to enable the
4 conference committee appointed to resolve the differences on House
5 Bill 3726 (preservation and maintenance of the Alamo by the General
6 Land Office) to consider and take action on the following matter:

7 Senate Rule 12.03(1) is suspended to permit the committee to
8 change text not in disagreement in proposed SECTION 2 of the bill,
9 in added Section 31.453(e), Natural Resources Code, to read as
10 follows:

11 (e) The land office may enter into an agreement with another
12 organization for purposes of this subchapter if the land office is
13 unable to enter into an agreement with the Daughters of the Republic
14 of Texas as required by Subsection (a) before January 1, 2012. On
15 the effective date of an agreement entered into with another
16 organization under this subsection, any reference in this
17 subchapter to the Daughters of the Republic of Texas means the
18 organization with which the land office enters into an agreement.

19 Explanation: The change is necessary to allow the General
20 Land Office to enter into an agreement for the preservation and
21 maintenance of the Alamo with another organization if a timely
22 agreement with the Daughters of the Republic of Texas cannot be
23 reached.
