WHEREAS, She also served as a volunteer, organizer, and fund-raiser with a number of charitable organizations, including the Palmer Drug Abuse Program, the American Cancer Society, the Leukemia Association, and the American Heart Association; and

WHEREAS, A woman of vision, determination, and strength, she gave generously to others, and her kind and loving spirit and humble nature will not be forgotten by those who were privileged to share in her life; and

WHEREAS, She was a devoted daughter, sister, wife, mother, and grandmother, and she will continue to live in the hearts and minds of those she left behind; now, therefore, be it
