WHEREAS, Following his military service, he returned to his hometown to begin a career in public service; he was first appointed to the Alamo Housing Authority and then to the Planning and Zoning Commission before gaining elective office as mayor in 1983; and

WHEREAS, He served as mayor until 1991, and he also served as city manager; he was elected as a city commissioner in 1992, and in 1995 he was reelected as mayor; he has fulfilled the duties of that office with honor and distinction since that time; and

WHEREAS, During his tenure as a city leader, Alamo's population has more than tripled, and he played an important role in bringing a wide array of businesses to the city and in taking the city's budget from a deficit to a sizeable surplus; his efforts have been invaluable in making Alamo an exceptional place in which to live, work, and raise a family: now, therefore, be it
